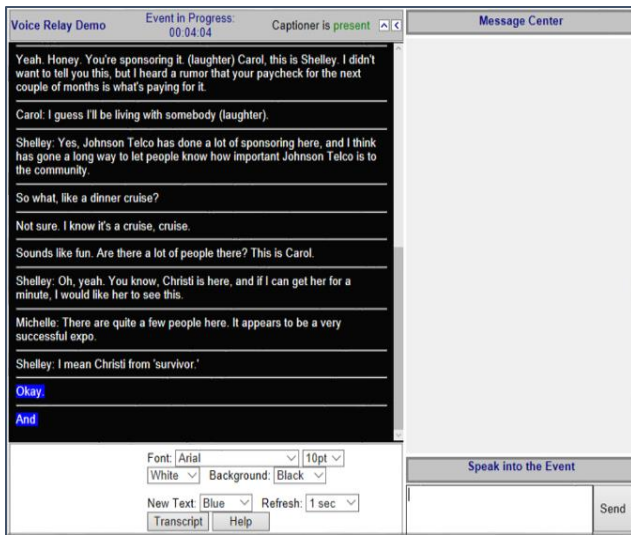


Sprint's Relay Conference Captioning interface has a new, improved look.

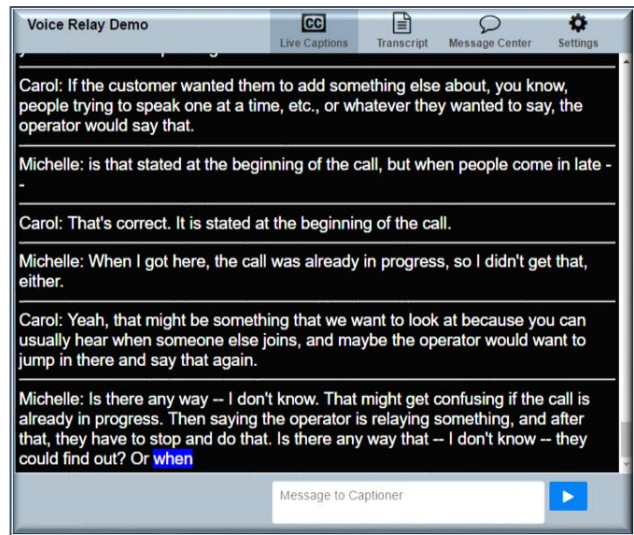
The new interface:

- Expands audience size for all Relay Conference Captioning events
- Improves existing redundancy and resiliency throughout the system
- Introduces a mobile-friendly, clean, responsive interface
- Provides end-to-end encryption

Old Interface:



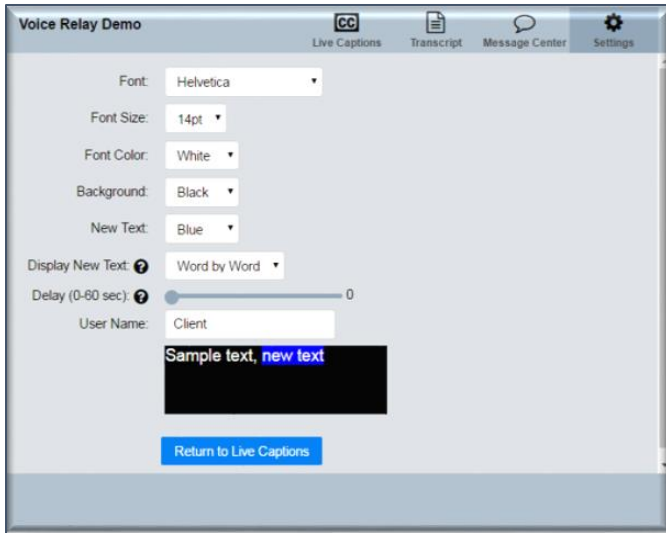
New Interface:



You'll notice the new interface has a clean look and feel. The interactive messaging feature for two-way communication is at the bottom of the screen vs. the right. The settings menu is accessed by clicking the gear at the top right of the screen.

Settings

Viewer options on our new interface have been expanded. We offer a larger choice of fonts, colors and font sizes. Users will now have the option to choose how they'd like captions to



display: buffered, a few words at a time, or as they are written, one word at a time, similar to how live captions appear on TV.

The Delay option will most often be used for those who embed the player in a webpage, and need to set a delay to accommodate video streaming time.

Responsive Webpage:

The new interface is fully responsive and may be resized for play on a phone or mobile device.
